To the Messiah community,

The past six weeks have been difficult as we address challenges facing our congregation. We have taken steps and made choices that are joyless but necessary for our congregation to survive.

Sunday, March 12, the MLC Council met and approved a severance package for Pastor Chris Heller. I wish this step wasn't necessary but I concluded it could not be avoided. Over the past 14 months, our membership and giving losses have become chronic and would become terminal without action. In truth, these losses began several years ago but haven't been reversed. I was informed several more families were considering leaving the congregation and decided the only chance to maintain Messiah Lutheran Church as a congregation was to make a significant change. The families who were considering leaving didn't pressure me into this decision. They did not, in fact, tell me they would take their giving elsewhere. However, it is very rare that a family who has joined another church continues giving to the church they left. Losing them would have meant also losing their giving and they would have merely joined a growing list of members who had already left.

We now move forward with sincere and deep appreciation for the ministerial gifts Pastor Chris brought to us. He provided individuals and families with tremendous support in times of great trial and need. His sermons are thoughtful and thought-provoking. One-on-one interactions with Pastor Chris are meaningful. These gifts will continue to serve Pastor Chris well. They are also facets we will actively seek in future.

Our next steps are already underway:

- We are seeking feedback on the combined service to determine if any further tweaks are needed.
- The pledge program has returned commitments to give ~\$2,400 per month. Only a small portion of our members have pledged so I consider this a healthy start.
- We will soon contact those who have left our community, tell them we miss them, and invite them to join us again.
- We will soon provide opportunities for all to engage and build our future.
- We have identified supply pastors for services through Easter.
- We are working to identify an interim pastor to begin as soon as possible after Easter.

Over the next few weeks to several years, we have much work to complete. We will rebuild our congregation in terms of members and giving. We will rebuild our benevolence beyond paying our bills. We will heal as a community.

'We,' now more than ever, means all of us. Please feel free to reach out to me or any Council member with concerns, questions, and ideas for our future. Together, we will move forward in God's service.

New L.I.F.E in Albuquerque

The L.I.F.E. Program stands for, "Liberty in Financial Education" and it will begin this month through a partnership between St. Timothy's Lutheran Church Albuquerque, the Rio Grande Credit Union, and Zia Elementary School. Our work with Ruth Hoffman and Lutheran Advocacy Ministry-NM called us to stand up against the devastating impact of predatory lending in New Mexico. St. Timothy's is located in an area inundated by these lenders. L.I.F.E. is St. Timothy's response.

Qualifying families from Zia will be given an application to the L.I.F.E Program, which includes 10 weeks of financial education followed by 24 months of financial incentives that allow families to put to work what they have learned in the 10-week program.




