If ever we who are gathered here at Messiah were to go into a journey of uncertainty, I think now is the right time. The season of Lent is upon us once again, and like our Lord wandered, we too are wandering. There are of course the obvious wanderings of Messiah Lutheran Church and its future, but there are also the wanderings of our own personal lives. Many of us are undergoing different life transitions. Maybe some of us are coming to grips with impending retirement or other career transitions. We do not enter into this season of uncertainty alone.

God is with us. Christ, our Lord, who walked an uncertain path to the cross, is with us in all uncertainty and doubt. Even when things aren't turning out as we hope, we are challenged to believe that God is present in all outcomes. And may we never cease to praise God for revealing the goodness of the journey to us all as we walk along the way. For we are not only blessed with a destination, we are blessed with a journey that prepares us for whatever comes next. May we seek to live more fully into God's future, trusting that God is present in whatever may come. And may we rely on one another in all things, knowing that in fellowship all challenges are made easier.

#### Treasurer's Report

#### January 2017

The P&L for January 2017 is attached. We had a loss of \$3594 for the month.

Per the notes on the conversation between the Kuljus and Pastor Sarah, I also printed the last four months of P&L for our review. Since the last three months include December, which is normally a higher income month, I thought a four month analysis would be more accurate.

In October we had an income of \$9022, expenses of \$16,979, for a net loss of \$(7956). Total payroll expenses were \$11,776.

November had an income of \$8496, expenses of \$13,974, for a loss of \$(5477).


December, we were in the black for \$5830 due to an income of \$16588, and a reduced payroll expense of \$8858. The reduction in payroll was due to confusion regarding payment for Pastor's paternity time. The paychecks we owed him for that time were issued in January.

January showed income of \$12949, expenses of \$16543 (\$13,445 payroll) for a loss of \$(3594).

As of today (February 10, 2017) we have \$31 in our checking account, and after a transfer to cover payroll, we have \$8627 in our money market account.
