Rides with "Gray Lady II" A Message from the Pastor

In the middle of the week following our Easter Sunday service and after Ron Hartenberger's funeral service, I did a good thing in my eyes and a bad one in "Gray Lady II's" eyes. ("Gray Lady II" is my 2009 Toyota Tacoma pickup truck ministry partner.) I went to the annual joint meeting of the two New Mexico Conferences of the Rocky Mountain Synod. The meeting was composed of Bishop Jim Gonia (RMS) and my colleagues from around the state (including Durango, CO and El Paso, TX). Our meeting was held at the Franciscan Holy Cross Retreat Center in Las Cruces, NM.


The meeting had a lot of introductions and sharing with pastors who usually do not see each other. It was interesting listening as we shared with each other the various things which were going on in our respective parishes and communities. A lot of the talk initially was consumed by conversations over how busy we had been during Holy Week and Easter. The consensus was that all went wonderfully, yet being tired was a common theme. There was conversation about a noticeable increasing public activity and attendance was increasing. There was the sense that the shutting in place, and now coming out, really caused a new feeling of need of community and spiritual awakening. A word that seemed to be consistent in the most recent months was a rise in people being engaged.

The Bishop also gave us updates of things going on in the Synod and also the fuller Church. He spoke of everything from how the Church in general (especially the ELCA) is seeming to show itself in ways that are new and challenging, yet good. One issue, not unsimilar to our situation, is how the Synod is working at looking differently about pastoral roles and lay people roles, especially as it is worked out concerning worship. We have a lot more congregations than we do pastors available to be called to them.

Now, as far as "Gray Lady II' was concerned I committed a grievous error. I did not have her take me for the trip to Las Cruces. I took "the other" vehicle. I am sure I will hear no end of it. She really did not miss much. It was a long drive of two-lane pavement, for the most part (road construction zones broke up that monotony). There were plenty of automobiles, motorcycles, trucks of various sizes, and one lone bicyclist. She could have seen a whole host of various traffic cones and directional signals which did not differ all that much in the ones we have in Albuquerque. To let you know, we do not have a monopoly on traffic cones here. University Ave which goes right by the NMSU campus and into town, had blocks and blocks of them. If you like brown and brush, you would have gotten more out of the trip than me. What was pleasing during the ride home was looking at the peaks on both vistas east and west of the interstate. The west peaks which continued on for a couple hours of driving provided a view of storm clouds dropping moisture. The campus setting for New Mexico State University was really beautiful.

OTHER ACTIVITIES AT MESSIAH

 Sew and Share—They will meet of the first and third Tuesdays of each month. They will meet in the Conference Room, at 9:30 am, with some food and fellowship following. Come and have a great time putting together quilts and working with other members of the church. The next gatherings will be May 2 and 16, 2023.

They decided this past year to make quilts for the **Linus Project.** The theme of the Linus Project is "Covering New Mexico with Love." Their quilts of different sizes will go to children in crisis in Bernalillo County. "The Bernalillo County Project Linus Chapter, established January 1999, has provided nearly 58,736 blankets to children in crisis." You are invited to participate in any way you feel you are able to assist in this project.
