Rides with "Gray Lady II" A Message from the Pastor

"Gray Lady II" (my 2009 Toyota Tacoma pickup ministry partner) is very dear to me. She has been so dependable and agreeable. We have been out driving in the various weather conditions of New Mexico and Colorado. Often, during the week, she sits out in the sun, on the driveway, when we are not out about doing different things. She knows the trip across town to Messiah quite well. She could probably drive herself to the church.

She is kept in the best maintenance condition for which I am possible to give to her. The basics are never forgotten, such as: regular oil changes, full fluid of the accessory mechanics, a new battery and cleaning. Admittedly, she does not get spiffed up as much as she should. Yet, there are things which get overlooked because they are not used frequently or consistently reviewed as they should. One case in point is the condition of the windshield wipers. They just sit there on the sweeping arm quietly aging. It is at the time when we need them, we find out that the rubber has disintegrated and the swiping off of rain in not as efficient as it should

be. At that moment, we realize that we should have been in touch with the condition of the wipers. We come to grips with how important they are when we are driving and want to be able to see out our windshield safely. So, now they get the attention they deserved and are replaced immediately.

Sometimes I wonder if we place the Lord's graciousness into a similar state in our lives. We people of faith know how valuable He is to us but yet when we have so many other things calling for our attention. We tend to forget to regularly call upon Him. We know He is our ever-present help in our time of need. When things get rough and we are at a moment which calls out for help, we fall on our knees. Otherwise, even with our best intentions to keep in touch with Him, we let the days past. It is not that we intentionally put Him aside but we fall short of consistently being at one with Him.

We may even place forth good intentions to regularly worship or read the Scriptures, but things of the world grab our immediate attention. He is our help in all present dangers but also smiling along with us during our joyous moments. Our faith needs regular and diligent maintenance. Not unlike every function and particular part of "Gray Lady II" needs our full attention, so does our relationship with the Risen Lord. He has promised to be with us always. And it is true, even if we do ignore Him at times, He is not apart from us.

A solid relationship of any kind needs devoted attention. It also needs attentive and dedicated communication. That is why daily reading of Scriptures, worship and prayer time is so important. When we are doing those things earnestly our Risen Lord and others of faith communicate with us. There are so many times when the Risen Lord would like to speak to us and we have not answered His call. He is always listening to our concerns, even if we do not recognize it. So, diligently keep focus on your faith maintenance and know you are at one with your Savior.
