We are in the week of Holy, with Easter being a little earlier than some years. It seemed like came upon us quite quickly. I was telling "Gray Lady II" (my 2009 Toyota Tacoma pickup ministry partner) how it caught me by surprise. My mind tells me Easter is an April event, but my mind was wrong this year. Just the same, it is a glorious moment for any year, at any time, reminding us of the great sacrifice the Lord had made to gain freedom for us from sinful consequences before the Father and the fear of death.
