Rides with "Gray Lady II" **A Message from the Pastor**

"Gray Lady II" (my 2009 Toyota Tacoma ministry partner) commented to me the other morning that things have been different for her over the last few weeks. She has had to use accessories of her vehicle which do not get to be used often. In the early mornings, when I went out to get her ready for one of our trips about town, she was shivering and her windows were not clear. She had to have her knob for where the heat went as her engine warmed to defrost. I had to even assist her with any ice scraper, a few times.

Then she pointed out that she was using her windshield wipers almost daily. Mostly, it was to get the dampness off, but there was rain and snow occasionally. Just the other damp, cool morning, she and I were going to go on a drive over to Messiah. She had been sitting for a few days. Her brakes gave notice that there had been moisture within the braking system, with a grunt and a few squeaks. As we got going, the brakes loosened up with usage. I noticed that my neighbor's brakes made the same noise as he was starting to head to his place of work.

I do not know how the amount of moisture we have lately been receiving measures up with other respective years, but it is sure nice. What has been especially gracious, has been how the moisture has arrived. The rain and snow have come down without such a speed and amount that it just ran off. It came down not in a heap, but spaced out with some quiet days in between the storms. In the past, I would have to go out and make sure that the ground around my roses was damp. These storms have taken care of that concern. And the trees are getting a good amount of winter moisture on their roots. If I may say it appreciatively, "It is nice to get free water from the heavens." The only plant I have had to regularly water is not where the rain or snow falls. It is the one given to me a few years ago from Messiah. Just to let you know that yesterday I saw new sprouts popping out of the pot's soil.



I believe, like the Psalmist and others of faith over the centuries, that God is ever-present and loves to provide and care for His people, His creation. As I was putting this letter to you the Psalmist's faith statements came to my mind, especially Psalm 147. Let me just share with you for reflection and faith support verses seven through eleven. He covers the heavens with clouds; He prepares rain for the earth; He makes grass grow on the hills, He gives to the beasts their food, and to the young ravens that cry, His delight is not in the strength of the horse, nor His pleasure in the legs of man, but the Lord takes pleasure in those who fear [cherish] Him, in those who hope in His steadfast love." It is so true we are His people, the creation is His creation, and we are His people, and His creation is His creation.
