Hopefully, you were able to enjoy in some way or other the past crazy and frustrating year.

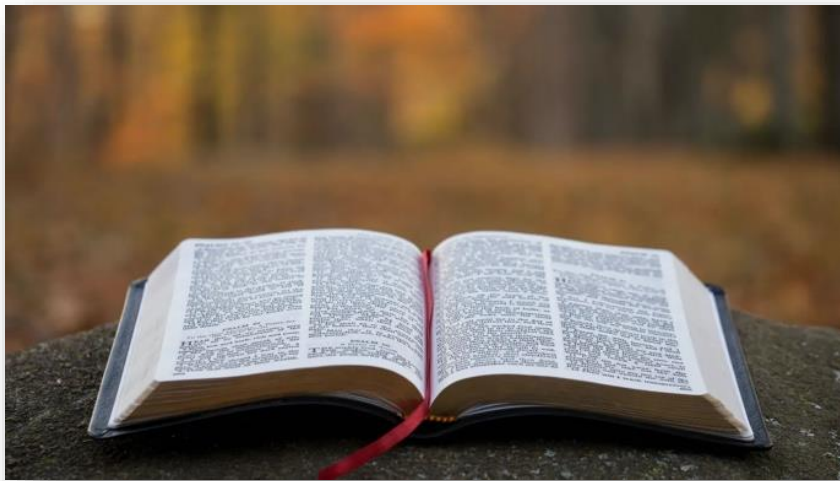


