Rides with "Gray Lady II" A Message from the Pastor

"Gray Lady II" (my 2009 Toyota Tacoma pickup ministry partner) and I have been driving around Albuquerque for quite a few years. Usually, she is quite content to get from place to place with the least amount of inconveniences. But the last few days she has seemed to be a little despondent. I thought it was the cooling weather and frost on her windshield. She even is showing her age in this cold weather with more noticeable creeks and groans. In fact, she sounds like me when I get up in the morning, so I can appreciate her condition.

So, I asked her what was bothering her. She was hesitant at first. She did not want to be a whiner, but she was disappointed with a few things. One, she pointed out that I have been driving her a little less lately. In my defense, I have been driving her with less frequently because with her years being advanced, I have chosen to have her travel less miles. I thought I was doing her a favor. I did not want to get to a point where we would have to part ways because of her inability to keep up with our driving needs.

She told me what really was getting her into a low feeling was that in her mind Christmas over. The lights and yard decorations which graced houses all around our home and travels would be coming down. It would go back to the "usual dullness". "Gray Lady II" enjoyed sitting in the driveway during the Christmas Season and at nighttime watching the transformation in the neighborhood. For her, now that will all be gone. "Woe is Me," she said to herself.

I could feel her despondency. It is so true that when the Christmas Season starts to unveil itself following Thanksgiving Day, the world in its celebratory way, begins to glow with lights, decorations and gift giving and receiving.
