Rides with "Gray Lady II" A Message from the Pastor

We are getting closer to Spring, each day. I can tell by the increasing amount and intensity of daily winds. The other day, "Gray Lady II" (my 2009 Toyota Tacoma pickup ministry partner) and I were out driving in the blustery and dust blowing mighty wind. I was whining to "Gray Lady II" about how the wind was such an annoyance to my golf game.

The winds were gusting so mightily that when putting it would blow the golf ball off the sloped greens. I had a putt which I got to stop about a foot from the hole and it stopped. I tried to hurry to the inert ball to mark its place, but then a gust of when beat me and the ball proceeded to roll off the green. This was not an anomaly, it happened often and not just to my ball. Others had the joy of watching their balls get blown rolling all over the place. I guess when we have winds gusts blowing up into the forty miles per hour, this phenomena should be expected.

"Gray Lady II" finally said to me after my belly aching, "Wah, Wah." She asked me how I felt about how her outer coat was getting sand blasted as we drove across town. As she was being buffeted around. she said she would be glad when the wind stopped and her travels would be less challenging. I agreed and dropped the topic and just held on tightly to her steering wheel. We both were fighting the wind.

Even though I did keep quiet before "Gray Lady II" this topic about the strength and persistence of the wind, I did not stop thinking about it. My mind went to the Bible and the activity of the wind written about it within. In the thoughts of the people of the Bible the wind was seen as caused by God. He started them, maintained them and stopped them. Even the direction for which the wind came had significance. North winds were seen as stormy and rain bringing in their territory. South winds were gentile and seen as helping growth. West winds were often mentioned as wells as East. West winds were remembered in the story of the Ten Plagues Yahweh brought against the people of Egypt in Exodus. It was the West wind which brought in the locust (Ex 10:19).

In Acts 2:2, we have provided by God a "mighty rushing wind." It can be translated also as a violent wind. A violent force which was seen as shaking up the calm of the day. The Greek here is "biaias pnoes". Acts 27:41, has a similar phraseology expressed as a very strong (of a wind). The Greek language quiet of used "anemos" for wind and "pneuma" for breath, wind and spirit. Keeping in mind the people of Jesus' day saw God active in many ways, even making wind blow and stop, for His good purposes for His creation, we need not forget the story of Jesus calming the sea in Matthew 8:27. We should not be surprised that those in the boat after Jesus appeared to them, told the strong wind to cease, that they would ask amongst themselves: "What sort of man is this, that even the winds and the sea obey him?"

God brought life into this creation by taking out of nothing (ex nihilo), chaos, and making something. He breathed (here the root word pneuma is used) life into a human form made out of the dust of the earth. That same word, which I mentioned above, can also mean wind or spirit. God is the active one in all that came into existence, remains so, and ceases to be.

We, a people of faith, need to take heed to the reality that the "wind," "breath" of God is maintained and cherished by His Holy Spirit. He blows through our lives with goodness and grace, even when we are frustrated by the blowing of the day about us. Jesus Christ died for us to be enlivened in a relationship with the Almighty. We are blessed to be in His care and ability to make wonder a life of faith. We may not see all that Our Lord does, but we can have the pleasure of knowing as He lives, lives in us, we too shall live, even in the stormy days of life. We may not have power over the winds of life or even understand their total purposes, but the One who does maintains the blessed purpose.
